**Autumn Ambles** are designed to be accessible for as many as possible. The walks will be approximately 6-7 miles in length with perhaps 1500 – 2000ft of climbing. Hopefully views will be good and the company excellent. They will only require normally walking gear (eg boots, waterproofs)

**Scrambles** are more challenging up to 10 miles and 3000ft with some scrambling/easy climbing en-route. They may require the use of additional equipment for safety reasons (eg helmet, harness, rope)
